Irma School Graduation Policy

Students who are welcome to participate (walk) in Irma School Graduation Ceremonies

Students wishing to walk must:

- 1. meet the minimum requirements to achieve a high school diploma or equivalent program completion for the province of Alberta
- 2. All fees assessed by Irma School and Buffalo Trail Public Schools must be paid. This includes fundraising activities that each student participated in.
- 3. Work Experience, RAP and Green certificate credits must have all paperwork submitted by May 1st of the graduation year to allow time to be compiled (if those credits are needed)
- 4. Must be enrolled in a minimum of thirty credits (30) in graduation year and must be passing those courses and/or earned credit in these courses prior to a May 1st deadline
- Distance Learning courses that are necessary to fulfill graduation requirements are needed to be half done and been marked by the teacher and be at a passing grade as of May 1st of the graduation year.

Alberta Education Requirements (for a high school diploma)

- Minimum of 100 Credits
- Must have English 30-1/or 30-2
- Must have Social Studies 30-1/or 30-2
- Minimum 20 level Math (Math 20-1/20-2 or Math 24)
- Minimum 20 level Science
- CALM
- Physical Education (3 Credits)
- 10 credits (CTS, Fine Arts, PE, RAP or WE)
- 10 credits at a 30 level, not including English or Social Studies.

Remember that post-secondary entrance requirements are specific to the school/s you wish to attend. Check each school to make sure you are meeting/exceeding their entrance requirements
