

Supply List for Junior High Students 2025-26

Math(7-9):

- Binder
- Loose leaf paper
- Small scribbler
- Scientific Calculator (Texas Instrument is preferred - TI-30XIIS) - **must** have a fraction feature ↓
- 1 small package of graph paper
- **Whiteboard markers - minimum of 4 - more may be needed later**
- Package of dividers
- Protractor, ruler, and compass



Science(7-9):

- Binder (can be shared with a second subject provided students take the time required and make an effort to stay organized as demonstrated and assisted in class - otherwise a second binder is preferred)
- Full-sized loose-leaf paper - not sheets of paper removed from a coil-bound notebook.
- Package of dividers (five will do - for five units of study - students may want more depending on their individual preference)
- Pencils, eraser, calculator - in pencil case so that it is always with the student and not in their lockers in the binder for a different subject.
- Colored pens (various - i.e. red, black, blue, green) - optional but highly recommended.

- Binder
- Package of dividers
- 2 different color highlighters

- Binder
- 2 Packages of dividers
- 2 different color highlighters
